

Lecturer (Above the Bar) in Biomechanics Panel Terms

- Following interview, successful candidates will be placed on a panel for a period of 12 months.
- Successful candidates will be offered suitable posts as they arise.
- Candidates may opt to take up a post which is offered, or remain on the panel until another post arises i.e. a candidate may decline a temporary post but can remain on the panel and be considered for a permanent post should one arise.
- Candidates on the panel who accept a temporary position will still be considered eligible for any permanent positions posts which may arise.
- It is possible that no suitable post may arise over the lifetime of the panel, in which case no offer will be made and no obligation on the University shall ensue.
- The panel will close after 12 months. At this point candidates will need to apply again for posts which are advertised.
- Posts may only be filled at the level advertised.
- There will be no second round of interviews.
