Frequently Asked Questions

1. Q. How much financial assistance would be available for international participants?

A. NSF fellowships are available to professors, postdoctoral fellows, and Ph.D. candidates from US universities. The fellowship consists of full tuition plus a travel allowance if applicable. Please see web site for application forms. In addition, please submit a two-page vita in NSF format and a 200-word statement indicating why the short course will help your career by **April 1, 2007.**
